## THE WORK BEHIND THE MISSION

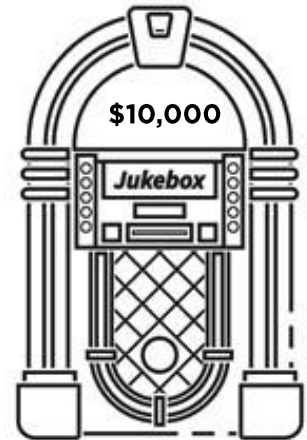

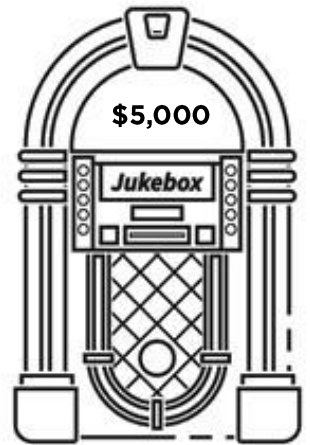
